BOARDING APPLICATION FEE SHEET AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **Application Process** All students must submit a completed application form for boarding. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, and placement will be secured only upon receipt of the application and required boarding fee deposit (\$5000).
- **Payment of Fees** A fee deposit of \$5000.00 is required at the time of application. This deposit is non-refundable as it guarantees the student's placement regardless of whether they accept the boarding offer or choose to withdraw from the application process. The remaining balance of the boarding fees must be paid in full by July 1, 2025 to secure the placement.
- **Security Deposit** A \$500 security refundable deposit (included in the total boarding fee payment). This deposit covers any damages to, or loss of, host family property caused by the student. Families will be held financially responsible if the cost of damages exceeds the deposit.
- **Payments Accepted** Payments can be made via Credit Card Wire Transfer, Google Pay, Apple Pay and must be received by July 1.
- **Refund Policy** The fee deposit is non-refundable under all circumstances, including but not limited to, withdrawal from the application process, refusal of placement, or inability to attend. Any further payments towards the boarding fee must be made as per the schedule provided.
- **Accommodation Confirmation** Once the signed agreement and deposit are received, the student's placement will be confirmed and an email will be sent with the payment of any outstanding fees.
- **Boarding Fees**
 - Shared Room: \$41,150.00 USD per year
 - Damage Deposit: \$500.00 USD per year (included in boarding fee)
 - Deposit due must be received at the time you submit your Boarding Student's Application \$5000.00 USD
 - Travel expenses such as flights, hotel stays, and personal travel are **not** included in the boarding fee schedule.

 - Shuttle services will be managed by licensed drivers and will follow a set schedule with designated pick-up and drop-off points.
